

Directions to Valencia Country Club:

From Los Angeles...

Take the 101 Hollywood Freeway to the 405 North, then take the 5 North and exit Valencia Blvd. Turn right onto Valencia Blvd. and then left at the next light (Tourney Road) Valencia Country Club is 1 mile down Tourney Road on the right. Use the first entrance. Registration and the bag drop off is at the front of the club house.

From LAX...

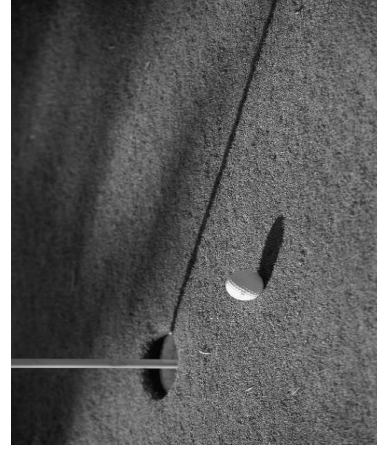

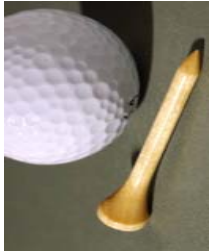
